As a Vendor, you will be allowed to *sell* food or beverages, and there will be nominal **fee of \$25.00**. You must obtain a **Special Event Food Establishment Permit**, as well as a **Food Handlers' Education Certificate**. You will need to provide your own **tent/ booth, chairs, tables, hand-washing station, gloves and electricity/power (if needed)**.
