Since you are serving food or beverages, you must obtain a Special Event Food Establishment Permit, as well as a Food Handlers' Education **Certificate**. You will be provided a 10'x10' space under a tent, one table (8'x3'), and 2 chairs. Your exhibit must fit within your allotted space. You will need to provide your own hand-washing station, gloves and electricity/power (if needed).

Once we confirm your registration via email, then we will also send you some additional consent forms, based on the type of products or displays that you have.
